



Parents and Cheerleaders:

We are excited about our upcoming season for the Cambridge Feeder Cheer Program. The Feeder Cheer program will be open to all rising 6th, 7th and 8th grade students that reside in the Cambridge High School attendance zone.

- The program consists of 3 football cheer squads for 6th, 7th, and 8th grades as well as one Competition Squad comprised of all three grades.
- Each participant will be required to attend Tryout Practices and Tryout Evaluations.
- The program's goal is to teach cheer fundamentals, and generate school spirit for our feeder programs, and prepare athletes for Cambridge high school cheer.
- Each cheerleader will be required to maintain a B average on their report cards. A cheerleader who fails to meet this requirement will be placed on probation and may be dismissed from the program.
- Cambridge Jr Cheer requires athletes and parents agree and abide by Cambridge Jr Cheer Code of Conducts/Standards of the program furnished at Registration and April Kick Off Meeting.

### **COMMITMENT & SCHEDULE:**

Regular football games begin in August and go through October. If a team makes it to play-offs, we will continue football cheer into late October or early November for that specific team. There will be at least 8 football games that each cheerleader will be REQUIRED to attend. If games are missed due to an unexcused absence, appropriate measures will be taken, up to and including dismissal from the cheer team.

- Sideline teams begin at the beginning of June and will practice over the summer and into the fall.
- Competition team practices begin in May! Competition team has a HIGHER level of commitment and should plan for 2-3 practices a week beginning in June with additional practices scheduled as well. Team members are expected to be at all practices. There will be approximately 3-4 competitions. Competition cheerleaders will be REQUIRED to attend ALL competitions as well as ALL practices, and ALL camp days. Appropriate measures will be taken for any unexcused absences; up to and including dismissal from the competition team.
- All cheerleaders will be required to attend choreography camp at Twister Allstars.
